Motion by Reed to approve a building permit for a deck for Larry and Karen Beitz. 2nd by Shafer. Approved. Resolution 2015.9: Resolution Setting Salary of David Sickles. Shafer introduced the resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Reed; and after consideration by the City Council, the Mayor called roll and the following named Council Members voted Aye: Reed, Sickles, Warrior, Dukes and Shafer. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted. Resolution 2015.10: Resolution Setting Salary of Samuel Groves. Sickles introduced the resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Reed; and after consideration by the City Council, the Mayor called roll and the following named Council Members voted Aye: Shafer, Dukes, Warrior, Sickles, and Reed.
