



Motion by Leo Armstrong and seconded by Art Baudler to adjourn. Carried.



Land Fill use by surrounding farmers was discussed and it was decided that those who have utality billing now may use the land fill for the same price as residents of the town.

Charles Euler met with the Council asking for more information about the water project. The results of the survey were discussed and tabled. It is hoped that more returns will come in. Only 139 of the 334 sent have been returned. Motion by Art Baudler and seconded by Keith Westphal to hire Paris Sullivan for the price of \$75.00 to remove four stumps from the park.

Motion by Keith Westphal and seconded by Jim Dickerson to put \$7000.00 of the Road Use Tax money in Time Certificates of Deposit for a period of six months. Carried.
