RESOLUTION OPPOSING SENATE FILE NO. 1125
_ (FISCAL YEAR BILL)

WHEREAS, Senate File No. 1125 (Fiscal Year Bill) initiated by the State Comptroller, enacted by the Second Session of the Sixty-Fourth General Assembly, and signed by the Governor of the State of Iowa violates the Spirit and intention of the Home Rule amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa; Violates the accepted accounting principles applicable to the affected governmental subdivisions as promulgated by the National Committee on Governmental Accounting and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants; and is Patenetly inimical to the best interests of of all the citizens of the State of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the enacted Fiscal Year Bill provides no benefits for the affected political subdivisions of the State of Iowa and actually would be harmful to the administration and operation of Iowa cities in that it would result in their accounting for street improvement programs, storm and sanitary sewer construction, water main construction, sidewalk construction programs, traffic signal projects, maintenance programs and recreational programs to be divided into two different reporting periods resulting

in confusion and inefficiency which the recommended planningprogramming-budgeting system of budget preparation and reporting was planned to overcome.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE

TOWN OF FONTANELLE, IOWA THAT:

The Town Council is opposed to the Fiscal Year Bill and petition its repeal by the First Session of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly of the State of Iowa.
