Motion by Art Baudler and seconded by Jim Dickerson to approve the re-appointment of Mrs. Clarence Martin and Mrs. Will Brown to six year terms on the Library Board. Also to accept the resignation of Mrs. R.E. Wiley and appoint Mrs. Genevieve Dodds to fill her unexpired term until July 1976. Carried.

Kenneth Armstrong met with the Council concerning the closing of the south 132 feet of the alley between Lot 6 & 7 in Block 18. He is to file a petition for closing so the Council may act on it.

George Killian's excessive water bill was discussed and the Council came to the conclusion that \$200 was a fair charge and that it could be paid over a 10 month period.

Motion by Harold Hardin and seconded by Art Baudler that a flat fee of \$200.00 be charged for hook-up on West Maple Street main and that the payment for both the West Maple hook-up and Fairview Addition be payable in 10 monthly payments, on the Utility Bill. Carried.

Street work was discussed.

ORDINANCE NO. 100  
AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE CEMENTING TO CURB  
ON EXISTING SIDEWALKS ON THE SQUARE IN THE TOWN  
OF FONTANELLE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FONTANELLE, IOWA, THAT:

Section 1. Cementing to the curb on existing sidewalks on the square in the Town of Fontanelle will be allowed. The property owner is responsible for the cost of removal and replacement of said concrete, up to a width from the curb of 24 inches, if removal is necessary for work on electric or water lines or any other purpose denoted by the Council.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and in effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.



WHEREUPON THE MAYOR DECLARED the following Ordinance duly adopted.

ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY BETWEEN LOTS 6 AND 7 OF BLOCK 18.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF FONTANELLE, IOWA:

Section 1. That the South 132 feet of the alley lying between Lots 6 and 7 in Block 18 of the Town of Fontanelle, Iowa is hereby vacated.

Section 2. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
