Jim Dickerson, Harold Hardin and Keith Westphal. Nays: None. Carried. Motion by Art Baudler and seconded by Jim Dickerson to recommend a Beer and Liquor License be granted to the American Legion, Carlson Post #247. Carried.

The Mayor was directed to sign the agreement with Adair County Towns pursuant to the "Solid Waste Disposal Report for Adair County, Iowa" and to contact Fred H. Miller about serving on the committee.

Keith Westphal is to contact A & D about the new door for the Town Hall. Alley and street work was discussed.

Motion by Harold Hardin and seconded by Jim Dickerson that the town pay half the cost of heating the Town Hall and the other be paid by Fire & Rescue Fund.

Motion by Jim Dickerson and seconded by Harold Hardin to adjourn. Carried.
