Section 3. <u>Form of Government</u>. The form of government of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa, is the Mayor-Council form of government.

Section 4. Powers and Duties. The Council and mayor and other city officers have such powers and shall perform such duties as are authorized or required by state law and by the ordinances, resolution, rules, and regulations of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa.

Section 5. Number and Term of Council. The council consists of five councilmen elected at large and elected for terms of four years.

Term of Mayor. The mayor is elected for a Section 6. term of two years.

The City Clerk shall keep an Section 7. Copies on File.

official copy of this Charter on file with the official records of the City Clerk, shall immediately file a copy with the Secretary of State of Iowa, and shall keep copies of the Charter available at the City Clerk's office for public inspection.

Section 8. When Effective. This ordinance is in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as required

by law.
