Thereafter and on said day there was filed the foregoing amendment and said amendment was duly considered by the Council.

The Council, being fully advised, found that a date of hearing on said estimate should be fixed for the 4th day of September, A.D., 1973 at 7:30 P.M. o'clock said hearing to be held at the Fontanelle Town Hall.

The Clerk was directed to publish the estimate and notice of hearing as required by law in the Fontanelle Observer, a newspaper of said county.

WHEREUPON THE MAYOR DECLARED the following Ordinance duly adopted.

Ordinance No. 103

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF FONTANELLE, IOWA, EMBODYING THE EXISTING FORM OF GOVERNMENT ON AUGUST 6, 1973.

Be It Enacted by the Council of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for a charter embodying the form of government existing on August 6, 1973.

Section 2. Charter. This ordinance may be cited as the Charter of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa.

Section 3. Form of Government. The form of government of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa, is the Mayor-Council form of government.

Section 4. Powers and Duties. The Council and mayor and other city officers have such powers and shall perform such duties as are authorized or required by state law and by the ordinances, resolution, rules, and regulations of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa.

Section 5. Number and Term of Council. The council consists of five councilmen elected at large and elected for terms of four years.

Section 6. Term of Mayor. The mayor is elected for a term of two years.

Section 7. Copies on File. The City Clerk shall keep an

official copy of this Charter on file with the official records of the City Clerk, shall immediately file a copy with the Secretary of State of Iowa, and shall keep copies of the Charter available at the City Clerk's office for public inspection.

Section 8. When Effective. This ordinance is in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 7-73

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO ACT UNDER AND BE SUBJECT TO CERTAIN DIVISIONS AND PARTS OF DIVISIONS OF THE CITY CODE OF IOWA, KNOWN AS THE HOME RULE ACT, CHAPTER 1088 OF THE ACTS OF THE SIXTY FOURTH IOWA GENERAL ASSEMBLY (1972), TO UTILIZE THOSE PROVISIONS DEEMED BENEFICIAL TO THE TOWN AND ITS CITIZENS.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Town of Fontanelle, Iowa; Section 1. ADOPTIONS. The Town of Fontanelle, Iowa, elects by this resolution to act under and be subject to the provisions of the following divisions, or parts of divisions of Chapter 1088 of the Acts of the Sixty-Fourth Iowa General Assembly (1972) set forth below as authorized by Division I, Section 9, of Chapter 1088.

Division I, II, IV, Part 1, & 2.

Section 2. CORPORATE NAME. The Corporate name of the Town of Fontanelle, Iowa, is changed to the City of Fontanelle, Iowa. All references to the Town of Fontanelle in the ordinances, resolutions, and other official papers and records are deemed to refer to the City of Fontanelle. All actions, proceedings, rights, or duties incumbent upon or due to the Town of Fontanelle or its officers survive and must be prosecuted to a conclusion. A judgment or decree against the Town of Fontanelle is enforceable against the City of Fontanelle or other party to the action. An agreement previously entered into by the Town of Fontanelle is enforceable by either party as the case may be. All assets, liabilities and rights of the Town of Fontanelle are hereby transferred to the City of Fontanelle.
