Vacation as follows with no carry over. First year--no vacation, Second year thur fifth year--5 working days vacation. Year 6 thur 15 allowed 10 working days vacation. 16th year--15 working days vacation.

Employees Delmer Miller, Gene Dillon and Lorraine Homan will be allowed seven paid Holidays per year which shall be New Years, Christmas, Memorial, Independence, Beterans, Labor and Thanksgiving. Said Employees must use their vacation within the year. The employees will be allowed to accumulate 90 days sick leave.
