The purpose of the meeting was to met with Willis Jongerius from Dewild, Grant, Reckert & Assoc. Co. of Rock Rapids, Iowa.

Mr. Jongerius presented a Power Supply Study of the Electric System.

Motion by Deane A. Darrow and seconded by Art Buadler for Mr. Jongerius to proceed to set up a workable plan at a per diem rate. (This is to be confirmed by letter.) Carried.
