RESOLUTION NO. 75.11

RESOLUTION APPROVING STATEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER PLANT AND SYSTEM.
