January 12, 1976 Fontanelle, Iowa

The City Council of Fontanelle met in Special Session at the City Hall at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Betty V. Burcham, presiding. Councilmen present were: Art Baudler, Randall Bond, Deane Darrow, Ralph Means and Keith Westphal. Absent: None.

The purpose of the meeting was a hearing for amendment of the budget being conducted. Thereafter and after hearing all taxpayers, of which none appeared, the council took up the amendment to the budget for final consideration and determined that said budget be corrected by changing the proposed expenditures as listed in the original budget from \$47,064 in the General Fund to \$67,064 and the Sewer Fund from \$3525 to \$8525. This Amendment does not increase taxation for the fiscal year but makes possible the spending of money already on hand. The vote on the final adoption was: Ayes: Art Baudler, Randall Bond, Deane Darrow, Ralph Means and Keith Westphal. Nays: None.

Mr. and Mrs. Richard Edsall were present to discuss the Well Project. A tentative Agreement and a new fence line was discussed.

Councilman Randall Bond introduced the Ordinance on Snowmobiles which was presented to the Council, for reading.

Motion by Deane Darrow and seconded by Keith Westphal that the rule requiring said Ordinance to be read on three different days be dispensed with and the roll was called and the vote was: Ayes: Baudler, Bond, Darrow, Means and Westphal. Nays: None. Carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF OPERATION
OF SNOWMOBILES ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHING
THE CITY AND ON PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OUTSIDE
THE CITY LIMITS, AND TO REQUIRE CERTAIN EQUIPMENT THEREON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Fontanelle, Adair County, Iowa that:

- A. DEFINITIONS. The provisions of State law defining certain terms as set forth in Section 321G.1 are hereby adopted.
- B. OPERATION ON ROADWAYS. The provisions of State law for operation of snowmobiles on roadways as set out in Section 321G.9, 321G.13, 321G.17 and 321G.20 are hereby adopted.
- D. OPERATION ON CITY PROPERTY.

1. No person shall operate a snowmobile upon any roadway or public street within the City of Fontanelle, Iowa unless during the snow season and such roadway or public street has not been plowed, or as allowed by (E.) or (F.) below.
2. No person shall operate a snowmobile upon any other property owned by the City of Fontanelle either within or outside the city limits.

E. SNOW ROUTE DESIGNATIONS.

The following streets are hereby designated as snowmobile routes for operation thereon during the snow season whether or not same have been plowed.

1. Summerset Street-East and West of 4th Street.
From Summerset Street south on 4th Street to Alley East between Scott and Main Street to 5th Street.
2. Maple Street-From Highway 92 east to 4th Street and from 9th Street west to 4th Street, thence North on 4th Street to Alley east between Main and Scott Street to 5th Street.

F. OPERATION ON DESIGNATED SNOW ROUTES.

1. Snowmobiles may be operated upon designated snowmobile routes and any other public street giving the most direct access thereto, excepting Highway 92 for the purpose of point to point transportation on the most direct route within the City from the place of residence of the snowmobile operator thereof to the city limits.

2. Snowmobiles shall be operated in a single file manner in the right hand lane of traffic.

3. Operators of snowmobiles shall yield the right-of-way to all other traffic which constitutes an immediate hazard.

4. Each snowmobile operator shall strictly observe all traffic signs and signals and all other traffic rules and regulations applicable to motor vehicles and shall obey the orders and directions of any peace officer of the City of Fontanelle who is authorized to direct or regulate traffic.

G. TOWING. It shall be unlawful to tow any sled or trailing object unless coupled to said snowmobile by a rigid towbar.

H. LIGHTS. All snowmobiles being operated within the City of Fontanelle, Iowa shall have the required headlight and tail-light lighted.

I. UNATTENDED SNOWMOBILES. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of a snowmobile to leave any snowmobile parked on any public property without the express written permission of the proper public authority.

J. PENALTIES. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

K. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any provisions or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not effect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

L. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law. PASSED this 12th day of January, 1976 and APPROVED this 12th day of January, 1976.

C. OPERATION ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. No person shall operate a snowmobile upon any private property within the City of Fontanelle, Iowa, without the express permission of the owner or tenant thereof.
