Councilman Keith Westphal, Fire Chief Raymond Stewart, and a sizable number of Volunteer Firemen were also present.

Motion by Bruce Westphal and seconded by Leo Jacobson to accept the minutes of the last meeting as read. Carried.

Motion by Leo Jacobson seconded by Ervin Ehm that the bill to the Farmer's Co-op Co. for the Shocks for the White GMC Truck be paid, when the bills arrives. Carried.

Committeeman Bond stated that Richland Township would be present, wishing to enter into agreement with the City of Fontanelle and Summerset Township

for fire protection and emergency services.

The Original Agreement between the Town of Fontanelle and Summerset Township was read by the Mayor.

Richland Township was represented by Township Clerk, Derwin Larsen, along with Trustees Earl E. Maeder, Ralph Rectenbaugh and Leo Wallace. They presented a list of 41 names of people that wish to be served by the Fontanelle-Summerset Township Fire Department. This would include thirteen (13) sections of Richland Township. It was noted that emergency services is a Rescue Service and not ^{just} an ambulance service.

Motion by Randall Bond to accept Richland Township on Contract for these 13 sections, and then to enter into an Agreement as soon as a new Agreement can be drawn up. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.
