NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Resolved by the Council of Fontanelle, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. That for the purpose of evidencing an amount payable the contractor for materials furnished and work performed under the contract referred to in the preamble hereof there be and there is hereby authorized to be issued an electric Revenue Pledge Order of the municipality in the form now on file with the Clerk, as follows:

Pledge Order No. 32 Contractor, Stake Construction Co. Amount: \$8,051.41

Section 2. That said Pledge Order shall be signed by the Mayor and attested by the Clerk, with the seal of the municipality affixed and be issued and delivered to said contractor as aforesaid in payment of that part of the aforesaid improvements referred to in the aforesaid statement.

Section 3. That all resolutions or orders or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
