All Correspondence was read.

There was discussion on the restrooms in the City Park being vandalized, the discussion was to decide on whether to close them permanently or to have them open. It was decided to have them open during the day.

Motion by Keith Westphal to have the City Rest Rooms open from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. daily with no paper towels or toilet tissue provided.

Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried. The Clerk was directed to put a notice in the paper to this affect.

The Fountain in the Park was also discussed. Since it is almost time for it to be shut off due to cold weather, it was tabled until the APRIL meeting.

Career Employment was discussed. Mr. Richard Martin had stated that there was no set wage for the student applying. Delmer Miller is to be responsible for the training and grading of the student.

Motion by Deane Darrow to pay \$2.00 per hour to the student applying for the Career Education Program. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.

Delmer Miller presented the Iowa Commerce Commission application for petition for franchise for an electric transmission line to the Water Supply Well & Treatment Plant. There was discussion on the underground wiring to Karl Woodrich & Frank Kaminky residences, and whether the City could deduct the trenching and wire from the final bill to Stake Construction Co., and if they would be responsible.

Painting the Digger/truck was discussed. Delmer stated that he did have one bid on painting, sanding, and taking out the dents.

Motion by Keith Westphal to have Delmer Miller get one more bid on painting, sanding and taking out the dents on the Digger/Truck, and to accept the lowest bid and proceed with the painting of it. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Keith Westphal give a report of the Municipal Meeting held at Cedar Rapids. One point of interest was the Ordinance Codification Service. All work is performed in Des Moines by professionals in working with Iowa cities and towns. It is understood that these men do the work to meet the Home Rule Act. Each code is tailored to meet the individual needs and desires of the officials of each community served. It is then evaluated and there is a conference with city officials for acceptance before printing.

The Lions Club is ready to put up their shelter. The Recreation committee is to show them where to erect it.

Dirt from the Legion slab is to be hauled to the City Lot. The Legion men will furnish the tractor & scoop. The City will furnish the Dump truck. There was discussion on the Park in general. It was thought that some type of weed killer & fertilizer should be put on. The price of this will be checked on.

Motion by Keith Westphal to adjourn. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

The City Council met in Special Session at the City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Betty V. Burcham presiding. Council members present were: Art Baudler, Randall Bond, Deane Darrow, Ralph Means and Keith Westphal. Absent: None.

Mr. Don Culver of Culver Engineering Co. of Jefferson, Iowa was present to file the plans and specifications on the Storm Sewer Project. He stated that the Project would cost more than originally planned, as another outlet was added and also the downspout on the Tower was added to the original plans. This is preliminary work to be followed by Street Improvement.

Councilman Baudler suggested that a complete review of the financial situation should be made before any final decision was made.

Mr. Tom Mehl, of Robert E. Schweser Co. of Des Moines, the City's financial advisor was also present at the meeting. He stated that the City does have the capacity to go ahead with the Project, but he felt that February would be a better time, since the City is still waiting to hear from the Grant for the Water Project.

Motion by Westphal to table the discussion on the Storm Sewer Project until the regular meeting to be held in January. Seconded by Darrow. Carried.

The Council is to make a decision on the C.P.A. at the next regular meeting.

There was discussion on hiring a new Policeman. The Council felt that anyone applying with Law Enforcement Schooling, and knowledge of the Law would be most helpful. Don Rivers is to take his two days off each week, but to stagger the days, and not have the same days each week.

Motion by Art Baudler to authorize the Mayor & Clerk to sign the License for Construction & Maintenance of Buried Transmission Distribution System. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.

Motion by Keith Westphal to send Kerry Miller to the Wastewater School to be held October 26, at Earling, Iowa, and to reimburse him after he presents his receipts. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Motion by Art Baudler to Adjourn. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.
