The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and approve of the referendum ballot to be advertized and printed.

Motion by Art Baudler to adopt the referendum concerning Ordinance No. 41.27 as drawn up, and have 500 printed for the November 8th Election. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

It was decided that if anyone comes in and asks for a ballot for this referendum, they should be given one, even though it is predominately the Municipal Election.

It was noted that Charles Cummins will dig the sewer line on North 4th Street, and will look at the project this coming week-end.

Since the mowing season is ended, the Mayor was ask to contact Judy Sickles, and ask if she would consent to cleaning the rest rooms daily and to haul the junk twice a week.

Motion by Keith Westphal to adjourn. Seconded by Dean Darrow. Carried.

The Fire and Rescue Committee met at the City Hall at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Betty V. Burcham presiding. Committee Members present were: Leo Jacobson, Ervin Ehm, Martin Tracy, Art Baudler, Randall Bond and Deane Darrow. Absent: None

Motion to accept the minutes as read by Leo Jacobson, Seconded by Martin Tracy. Carried.

The Financial report was given by the Clerk. Total receipts for September and October were \$4827.59, with expenditures for the same period of \$1198.47, leaving a balance as of October 27th of \$6785.19.

Chief Ray Stewart, John Stutzman and Delmer Miller were also present.

John Stutzman presented the plans and estimated costs of repairing the fire station and also the 16'x40' addition for meeting room with bathroom & shower. Materials and insulation for the old part of the station and to be covered with Red with White trim steel siding, plywood ceiling installed at an estimated cost of \$5,000. Labor to put in insulation and putting on siding-\$1980. Estimated cost around \$7,000.

Materials for new addition (16'x40') \$3,000. Labor to build this new addition with plumbing and wiring included-\$1840. Total estimate of the project-\$11,820.00

Delmer Miller and John Stutzman had met with Representative Tom Harkin's aide, to see whether there was money available for a grant for a new fire station. They explained that this would have to be done through the governing board. Mr. Ted Hauser of SICOG is to contact either John or Delmer and set up a meeting at which time the committee would meet with him. A new Civil defense System would also be included along with the new fire station.

Due to this pending meeting, the committee decided to table the discussion of remodeling the old fire station.

Chief Stewart reported that the Firemen are going to have a dance on November 19th to raise money for needed equipment. Classes have been held on Basic Life Support Instruction.

Loyal Goff had ask the Firemen to burn buildings on his farm. Chief Stewart is waiting for approval from the State Fire Marshal, and if approval is given, November 13th is the day set for the burning, with other fire departments ask to participate.

Motion by Ervin Ehm to buy 100 feet of 1 1/2 inch fire hose. Seconded by Art Baudler. Carried.

There being no further business, Motion was made by Leo Jacobson to Adjourn. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.
