

The City Council met in Special Session at the City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Betty V. Burcham presiding. Council Members present were: Art Baudler, Deane Darrow, Ralph Means, and Keith Westphal. Absent: Randall Bond.

Motion by Deane Darrow to approve the renewal application for a Class C Liquor License for Rend Nagrassus d/b/a Joey's Tavern. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.

The City Council proposed dropping any further correspondence with Mr. Van Murray regarding the easement for the Storm Sewer, but to Contact the Engineer to go ahead and back the drainage to the adjoining property where the easement has been secured.

Jim Bakerink was present to meet with the Council regarding the job as Street Maintenance man. His duties would be to oil, rock and grade street and take care of snow removal. He would also be in charge of the Lift Station Sanitary sewer and Storm Sewer within the City Limits. The Council ask that the streets and alleys be watched for holes and see that they are repaired before damage becomes greater. The Street Sweeper is to be repaired and used, and the broom should be put on trucks so that it could be pulled with the Tractor. Jim would be answering to the Committee Chairman which is all in all the entire Council. The machinery should be allotted to the department and that department is to see that all are kept in good repair. Delmer and Kerry Miller are to assist if they are available, and if Jim is not busy with other duties, he is to assist Delmer & Kerry in their work.

Jim would be allowed the seven paid holidays. Since he has had a lot of mechanical experience, it was felt by the Council that this would account for a somewhat high wage.

Motion by Deane Darrow to hire Jim Bakerink at \$7,500 for a 90 day trial basis, and on March 1st raise the wage to \$7,750 if all is satisfactory. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.

Ordinance #41.27 was brought up, but the matter was tabled until the next regular meeting.

Motion by Keith Westphal to adjourn. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.

RESOLUTION OF FONTANELLE CITY COUNCIL TO ENTER INTO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT CREATING THE ADIAR COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Fontanelle City Council of Fontanelle, Iowa met in Special Session on this 29th day of November A.D. 1977 and;

WHEREAS, said City Council has made investagation into the feasibility of associating with the Adair County Public Safety Commission, and;

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate and make possible this joint cooperation in the exercise of governmental powers and by the authority granted this governmental body by Chapter 28E of the 1977 Code of Iowa,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fontanelle City Council of Fontanelle, Iowa, does resolve to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement creating the Adair County Public Safety Communications Commission.
