Committee Reports were heard and correspondence was read.

Maxine Queck, Lucille Raasch, Mildred Pickrell and Fred Burcham were present at the meeting. Mrs. Queck reported that Evelyn Eblen had problems with snowmobiles going through her yard. It was noted that Mrs. Eblen must file a complaint with the Police, and must be willing to testify in the complaint.

Mrs. Raasch and Fred Burcham stated their feelings on the Ordinance regarding minors in taverns.

Electrical Meter Testing will start in April. The meters are to be tested every 8 years.

The Control Panel for the Water Treatment plant has arrived, and will be installed starting later this week.

Officer Lowe stated that all Police are to wear a uniform that is visible to the public, and ask that Merrill Jones have a police uniform jacket.

Motion by Ralph Means that the City buy a Police Uniform Jacket for Merrill Jones. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Since the City does not have a part time person hired to take care of the garbage pickup, Councilman Deane Darrow contacted Metzger Sanitation about pick up. Motion by Keith Westphal to hire Metzger Sanitation to pick up the garbage in the barrels around the square for an additional \$5.00 per month and the City will furnish the bags. Seconded by Art Baudler. Carried.

There was a lengthy discussion about snow removal and other city employment. The Council explained that Jim Bakerink was hired to take part of the responsibility off Delmer Miller, and Delmer is to help Jim learn how to do some of the tasks, and after the first year is to give full responsibility to Jim for the streets and the sewer within the city limits. In case of severe storms Jim is to ask for help, and if Delmer is tied up with Electrical or Water problems, then Jim is to contact the Council. Kerry Miller is to supervise the Lagoon, and work on Water projects, besides helping on other projects.

There is to be a SIMECA-CIPCO meeting on March 23, At the Rolling Prairie Inn in Des Moines.

There was discussion on the hiring of a new City Attorney. The Mayor and Council will take this under advisement, and decide at a later date.

Closing of alleys was discussed, along with the removal of snow on sidewalks. Sidewalks should be cleaned no later than 12 hours after it has quit snowing.

Waste Water Schooling will be starting March 7 in Atlantic. Motion by Ralph Means that Kerry Miller is to attend Waste Water School in Atlantic, and the City will pay for the registration and mileage. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Motion by Deane Darrow to Adjourn. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.
