The City Council met in Special at the City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Pro-Tem Deane Darrow presiding. Council Members present were: Ralph Means, Keith Westphal Art Baudler and Deane Darrow. ABSENT: MERLE LECHTENBERG

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss water main extensions and repairing the Library Roof. Charles Cummins met with the Council regarding the digging of water mains. The Council decided that plastic pipe would be used, and the main extensions would begin at the corner of 9th and Maple, going 1 block north to Jefferson Street and then east to make a loop to pick up the Gene Smith and Charles Dalke properties. Mr. Cummins will check on the price of pipe. He stated that they would put the pipe together but City employees would be needed. There was also discussion about running a water main extension to the Ervin Queck property in the northwest part of town. Motion by Ralph Means to hire Cummins Construction to do the digging to install 4" plastic water mains on the two projects, namely to the Charles Dalke and Ervin Queck properties. Seconded by Art Baudler. Carried. Ted Wallace and Bob Wallace met with the Council regarding the repair of the Library Roof, and presented their estimate. They estimated 18 squares Rapid Roof would cost \$810. with \$65.00 labor for a total of \$875.00 The "Rapid Roof" product carries a 5 year guarantee of being 100% waterproof. Motion by Keith Westphal to hire Ted and Bob Wallace to put on a new roof using "Rapid Roof" on the library for the quoted price of \$875.00. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried. Motion by Deane Darrow to adjourn. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.
