Streets were discussed and it was decided that 1 load of oil and 3 loads of chips should be ordered immediately.

Mr. Lloyd Palmitier of the Gas Company met with the Council. He reports that the Gas Company is still taking new customers. The Company does extend 100 feet per customer, for those wanting to hook up.

Mrs. Jim Dickerson and Don Bohling met with the Council regarding the burying of the TV cable from the Lutheran Church to the Good Samaritan Center. Mrs. Dickerson objected to the cable going through her yard and the disturbing of her established lawn. The Council decided to put the cable east approximately 30 feet from the present mapped out location, to avoid any conflict.

The Council felt that it was up to the Lutheran Church to furnish its own light in the parking lot, since it is the Church's lot.

A meeting of the Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities is to be held in Des Moines from Sept. 17th thru 19th.

Motion by Keith Westphal to send Delmer Miller to the I.A.M.U. meeting in Des Moines, September 17th through 19th and to pay his expenses. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Motion by Deane Darrow to have the Blue Ford pick-up taken to S&S Ford Garage for repairs. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.

Motion by Art Baudler to contact Midstate Engineering Co. of Creston to do surveying of streets in Arnolds Addition. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.
