Councilman Deane Darrow recommended that Andy Gentle be appointed as new Councilman to fill the vacancy of Merle Lechtenberger who had resigned.

Motion by Art Baudler that Andy Gentle be appointed as Councilman to fill the unexpired term of Merle Lechtenberger. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Mr. Gentle was sworn in as Councilman by the Clerk.

Committee reports were heard and correspondence read.

The Council was informed that the Percision pump would cost approximately \$895.00 and the mixer \$210.00 which would include all equipment for installation. If the pump company was to install it, they charge \$150.00 per day. The pump and mixer are needed for the adding of caustic soda to correct the pH of the water.

Motion by Deane Darrow to have Kirkham, Michael and Associates of Omaha, order the precision pump for the Water Treatment Plant. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.

The Police department related that new snow tires are needed for the Police Car and also the front end should be aligned. Councilman Ralph Means and Merrill Jones, Marshal, are to see that this is done.

Complaints about a white police dog being on the loose and causing damage were discussed. Marshall Jones states that it has no license or rabies shots registered at the Court House, so he was instructed to issue a citation or shoot the dog if possible.

Complaints about the icy intersections were discussed. Councilman Ralph Means said he would ask the County about getting the salt and sand mixture and a spreader, and inform the Council of the cost.

Steve Marckmann had ask about acquiring a liquor permit for a bar which would be limited to adults only. Since he did not inform the Council where it would be located, no action could be taken.

Applicants for the job of Marshall were interviewed. Those namely were Eugene Robbins of Bridgewater, Jack Price of Anita and Merrill Jones of Fontanelle. Final decision is up to the Mayor.

There was a lengthy discussion on the new City Code and the corrections the Council felt should be made.

Motion by Deane Darrow to adjourn. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.
