The water committee reported that all the equipment had been received for the installation of the caustic soda chemicals, but it has not been installed as of this date. There has been no pumping from the east well since the control is broke. The City has had a sizable number of frozen water pipes this winter. Delmer Miller suggested that it was time to get D.E.Q. approval on the 4" water main extension and to order the materials for the project in the northwest part of town. Since the Electrical peak time is from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. it was related that the public should be

made aware of this and their co-operation needed to cut down at this time of day.

Dean Greenwalt resigned his position as relief man on the Police force.
