Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa:
Section 1. Chapter 2, Article 9, Section 2.1-2.0901, Paragraph 1
is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

Fourth Street, shall be southbound from Summerset Street to Benton Street.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudgication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
