Departmental Reports were heard.

The electrical fault on Maple Street has not been repaired at this time. If weather permits it will be done in the very near future. The Council suggested that the holes that were dug should be covered.

Delmer Miller stated that most of the water hook-ups had been completed, and only the hook-up for Robert Darling remains. There was discussion on country residents hooking on to the existing water transmission line. Intentions were that the city could hook others on, as the taps had been installed at the time the transmission line was laid, and the Council stipulated that it would be for household use only.

Motion by Ralph Means to allow Charles Cummins and Frank Jensen to hook up to the Municipal Water Supply at the regular charge of \$250. (for household use only). Seconded by Andy Gentle. Carried.

Marshall Merrill Jones stated that the School had ask him to enforce the "one way" area at the schoolground, since there is a Do Not Enter sign there. The Council felt that the City had no jurisdiction over school property, and the Mayor was ask to contact the Lawyer about the matter. The Adair County Sheriff's Posse had helped patrol the street at Halloween and also on the Fourth of July. It was suggested that a donation be given to the organization.

Motion by Deane Darrow to donate \$50. to the Adair County Sheriff's Posse. Seconded by Ralph Means. Carried.

The Mayor informed the Council that he had contacted Marvin Huddleson and Charles Dahlke about buying the north 16½ feet of Washington Street and they were willing, but he had been unable to contact Jerry Zimmerline.

Motion by Ralph Means to get a new Front Door installed at City Hall. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

Delmer Miller ask the Council to buy insulated coveralls for the three employees working out in freezing weather, and presented the price of the coveralls; \$55.95 plus \$6.25 with hood. The Council told him to check further on prices.

Motion by Deane Darrow to adjourn. Seconded by Andy Gentle. Carried.
