There was discussion on the sale of old used poles. A letter was read from the Pioneer Lumber Company, stating that none were usable that they had picked up which was the reason the City had not received any money for them. It was related that the employees should take up with the Mayor any matter of disposing of used property, and the Mayor is to inform the Council on the matter.

Mr. Andy Baird of the Southern Iowa Council of Governments was present to meet with the Council regarding Industrial Development Incentive Grants.

Motion by Andy Gentle that the City of Fontanelle elects to participate in the Incentive Grant Program with the Southern Iowa Council of Governments. Seconded by Art Baudler. Carried.

DEQ reports had been given to the Council, stating that the Council should be aware that a new water supply tower should be considered at a future date, old wells not being used should be recapped, and that an Emergency electric standby should be considered for the Water Treatment Plant in case of an electrical outage.

Delmer Miller reported that more electric underground wire is needed, but is in very short supply from all companies. The Council ask him to get price quotes and delivery dates.

Motion by Deane Darrow to have Delmer Miller order approximately 10,000 feet of underground wire, using his own judgment on ordering. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.

Motion by Andy Gentle to have Missouri Basin Municipal Power Agency act as legal representative to negotiate a wheeling contract with Central Iowa Power Co-op. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.

Motion by Keith Westphal that all Water hook-ups outside of the City Limits will be \$250. for the privilege and all other expenses shall be made by the user, with no less than 160 p.s.i. pipe to be used. Seconded by Deane Darrow. Carried.

The Clerk notified the Council that a Transfer of \$1112.05 from the Water Utility Fund to the Water Sinking Fund was needed as recommended by the Auditor. The Council gave their approval.

There was discussion on filling the old well located at the Library, and capping it. Ways are being considered on how to remove the water, and fill the well.

Art Baudler ask for Council approval to raise his sidewalk level and have a tube installed.

Motion by Deane Darrow to allow Art Baudler to have the sidewalk raised at his residence, and the City to furnish the dirt and tubes to connect to the existing storm sewer. Seconded by Keith Westphal. Carried.

Ceiling Materials for the shop was discussed. Delmer Miller is to contact some of the contractors, inquiring as to prices of materials and labor.

Motion by Deane Darrow to adjourn. Seconded by Keith Westphal Carried.
