RESOLUTION NO. 80.4

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEARING ENDING JUNE 30, 1980.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fontanelle, Iowa:

Section 1. Following notice published February 21, 1980, and the public hearing held February 28, 1980, the current budget is amended as set out herein. General Fund* Community Protection from 28,650 to 36,350. Reason: Unanticipated expense of buying land for future fire station. Water Utility Fund from 59,360 to 84,360. Reason: Sale of Water General Obligation Bonds.

There will be no increase in tax levies to be paid in the CURRENT fiscal year named above. Ant increase in expenditures set out above will be met from the increased non-property tax revenues and cash balances not
