Reason: Unanticipated expense of buying land for future fire station. Water Utility Fund from 59,360 to 84, 360. Reason: Sale of Water General Obligation Bonds.

There will be no increase in tax levies to be paid in the CURRENT fiscal year named above. Ant increase in expenditures set out above will be met from the increased non-property tax revenues and cash balances not

budgeted or considered in this current budget. This will provide for a balanced budget.
