BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL of THE CITY OF FONTANELLE; Iowa: The annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981, as set for in the Budget Summary Certificate and in the detailed budget in support thereof showing the revenue estimates and appropriation expenditures and allocation to programs and activities for said fiscal year is adopted, and the Clerk is directed to make the filings required by law and to set up the books in accordance with the summary and details as adopted, in the total amount of \$454,978.

Restrooms in the park were discussed. The entire Council is to survey what needs to be done, and report at the next meeting. It was also decided to put up a sign "No Pets Allowed in the Park". Delmer Miller informed the Council that the floor of the Bandstand is in bad need of repair.

Projects for the summer were brought up. Wiring should be finished in the Fairview Addition and also the street past the property of Mrs. Virnen Miller, in the Fairview Addition. Some trees are to be removed.
