ORDINANCE NO. 112

"AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNFAIR OR DISCRIMINATORY HOUSING PRACTICES"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FONTANELLE, IOWA:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u> The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the general welfare of the citizens of Fontanelle, Iowa by declaring discriminatory proctices in housing to be against public policy, and to provide for proper procedures for the enforcement of this ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Discriminatory Practices Defined</u> It shall be an unlawful discriminatory housing practice to engage in any of the following acts, if they are based on race, creed, color, age, disability, sex, national origin, religion, or ancestry:

1. Refusing to sell or rent to, deal or negotiate with any person.

Discriminating in terms, conditions or privileges for buying, renting or any transfer of housing.

3. Discriminating by advertising that housing is available only to persons of a certain race, etc....

4. Denying that housing is available for inspection, sale, or rent when

in fact it is so available.

5. For profit, persuading owners to sell or rent housing by telling them that minority groups are moving into the neighborhood.

6. Denying or making different rates, terms or conditions for home loans by commercial landers, such as banks, savings and loan associations and insurance companies.
