Their main question was to ask the Council if they objected to issuing another liquor license. As yet they have not purchased the building, so the Council agreed that when more definite plans had been made they would again take up the matter, but for the time being they would table the matter.

Motion by Deane Darrow to approve the applications for a Liquor License and Cigarette Permit for Robert J. Ball dba The Hitching Post Lounge. Seconded by Robert Weiland. Carried.

Delmer Miller stated that he have to have 10 hours of C.E.U.Units by April 1, and plans to attend a Water Treatment School this month.

It was decided that the employment of James R. Dawson was no longer needed, and that the Clerk should inform him by letter, and ask that he turn in his badge.
