438 in a Resturant/Lounge with an adjoining game room. They felt that the Area does not have any Special place for the teenagers to go. It would be a NightClub for Teenagers with no liquor served on Teenage Night. They also discussed the possibility of having a Special night for Older people. They would like to put in a game room, which would be supervised. Since they would be open only in the evenings and week-ends they felt they would not draw from the regular business of the two taverns and the two resturants that are now in business. Their main question was to ask the Council if they objected to issuing another liquor license. As yet they have not purchased the building, so the Council agreed that when more definite plans had been made they would again take up the matter, but for the time being they would table the matter.
