## ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF FONTANELLE, IOWA 1978, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PRETAINING TO ELECTRIC RATE CHANGE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FONTANELLE, IOWA:

Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 6, Subsection 6-7.0102 Paragraph 1-A,& B; 2 and 3. is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

The rates for electric service shall be as follows: Domestic Electric Service. Residential domestic electric service shall be available to all service users through one meter for one family as follows:

A. Residential hot water heater rate: Minimum rate \$5.25

> First 100 kwh @ 6.8¢ 300 kwh @ 3.0¢ 400 kwh @ 2.8¢ Next800 kwh @ 2.3¢

Residential non-hot water heater rate: Minimum rate \$5.25

First 100 kwh @ 7.5¢ Next 300 kwh @ 3.8¢ 400 kwh @ 2.8¢

Commercial service shall be at the Commercial Rate: Commercial service s following rate through a single meter 2. Minimum rate \$5.25

> First 100 kwh @ 11.0¢ 900 kwh @ 5.3¢ NextOver 1000 kwh @ 3.8¢

Electric Heat Rate Minimum rate \$5.25 2.2¢ per kwh

Power Cost Adjustment: If wholesale power cost should increase for different months, this will be vharged as an addition to

the above rates. PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON THIS 16th day of March, 1981, and APPROVED this 16th day of March, 1981.
