Departmental reports were heard.

Delmer Miller reported that he had sent the voltage regulator to GE Co. at Eldridge, Ia. The repairs to fix it would cost \$5472. and a new regulator would be approximately \$4828. with a 4 to 8 week delivery. He ask that the front controls be returned to us so they could be used as repairs. The Crew is working on underground installation in the south end of town.

A new water pump has also been ordered.

Delmer also reported that there had been two plugs in the sewer line that had been taken care of.

The matter of water running through the pasture of Albert Ehrenfried and through Terry Jaschke's garden is thought to be surface water. Location of the outlets of tiles is yet to be determined.

The Council informed Marshall Jones that the restrooms should now be opened. Marshall Jones ask that some new trash barrels be purchased.

Motion by Deane Darrow to buy four (4) new trash barrels. Seconded by Robert Weiland. Carried

Glen Rohner met with the Council to discuss the closing of the east-west alley adjoining his property along the south side.

The Council discussed the possibility of looking into the feasibility of power costs from Missouri Basin Power Agency.

The Mayor had talked to Posse members. The posse is willing to help at any time, and all they ask is that the City furnish the gas for their cars. They will help patrol on July 3, and 4th,

Marshall Jones proposed the plan of building a dog kennel, and the City to furnish the dog food until the dog is claimed or disposed of. A charge would be made to the owner of the dog to get the animal back.

The Mayor is to contact Mr. Rodger Blanchard about painting the Band Stand and other equipment in the park.

The street being built to the property of Mrs. Virnen Miller will be graveled as soon as enough dirt has been put in. Next year the Council plans to have it oiled.

Denny Davis informed the Council that he had a good used lawnmower for sale for approximately \$2,000. and would allow around \$185 for the one we now have.

Harold Veatch ask to have city water run to his building sometime this summer.

There being no further business Andy Gentle made the motion to adjourn. Seconded by Robert Weiland. Carried
