Mr. Jensen also stated that possibly if he waited until spring another Council may feel differently about the situation. Mrs. Jensen said that by spring the ground would have a chance to settle more.

Motion by Deane Darrow to delay the replacing of the sidewalks until spring after the ground has settled and the frost goes out. Seconded by John Stutzman. Carried.

Motion by Denny Sickles to pay Southern Iowa Council of Governments the \$667.00 due for Industrial Development Course to be presented in August. Seconded by Harold Veatch. Carried.
