

Harvey Wallace had presented the Council and Mayor a letter to read explaining the pro's and con's of going along with SIRHA. After a very lengthy deliberation it was decided to maintain the decision they had reached on March 29, 1982 and reject the proposition on both properties.

The Clerk presented papers to the Council regarding the Flouridation Grant and read the letter of instructions. It was decided that the Clerk is to contact Kirkham, Michael and Associates (Mr. Scott McIntyre) and ask the firm to attend the next regular Council meeting if possible.

There was discussion on a bill from Tom & Cindy Kester regarding the repairing of their mailbox, in the amount of \$43.68. The Council felt that an inspection should be made to see if it was back away from the edge of the road far enough before paying the bill. Since the County Road crew cleans and sands that portion of the city street they felt the City could take care of the bill, or the County would refrain from maintaining the road.

Roger Candee stated that the Garden Club wants to put up-dated equipment in the park. He had visited with a Lions Member from Massena and found out that a 50/50 Grant was available for recreation up-date. He also ask if the Council thought that a third shelter house was needed.
