He estimated that 5 Or 6 transformers would be needed, also all insulators would have to be changed at the football field. Both projects will entail a considerable amount of time and money.

Section 2. HOURS, HOLIDAYS AND OVERTIME:

Overtime will be paid at the rate of time and one-half to employees Delmer Miller, Kerry Miller, Dale Sickles, and Jack Zimmerline for the time spent beyond the regular 40 hour week.

Vacation as follows with no carry over. First year--no vacation. Second year through fifth year--5 working days vacation. Year six through fifteen allowed 10 working days vacation. Sixteenth year 15 working days vacation.
