October 25, 1982

The City Council met in Special Session at the City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Ralph D. Means presiding. Council Members present were: Harold Veatch, Kenneth Perry, Denny Sickles, Robert Weiland and Gene Jacobsen. Absent: None.

The purpose of the meeting was to hire a new Marshall and a new deputy marshall. Mr. Ronald Highland had consented to take the full time police work if the Council agreed. He ask for an annual wage of \$13,500. for the approximate 50 hours per week, but this does not include any mowing of the park and other city properties. He expressed his desire to go to the Law Enforcement Academy.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to hire Ronald Highland as City Marshall at an annual wage of \$13,500. Seconded by Harold Veatch. Carried.

Since the hard cell flashlight belongs of Merrill Jones the City will have to purchase a new flashlight for Officer Highland. He suggested that the City consider a rechargable model which will not have to have batteries replaced. He also ask that a file/folder be considered.

The Mayor informed the Council that Linda Benoit of the Area XIV C.E.T.A. Services had contacted him about hiring a part time policeman. She told the Mayor that the program would pay 50% of a trainee's wages up to 40 hrs. per week for a period of six (6) months. The Council then ask that Mr. Dean Sueck be called and asked to come to the meeting. He was instructed to get a concealed weapon permit. The uniform jacket that the City had on hand will fit Mr. Sueck, but shirts and pants will have to be purchased. Mr. Highland will also be needing a Uniform jacket, shirt and pants.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to hire Dean Sueck for 40 hrs. per week at a wage of \$4.75 per hour. Seconded by Harold Veatch. Carried.

Mr. Sueck will work 20 hours a week in Police Work and the other 20 hours taking care of the park, sidewalks and other Municipal duties.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to have an Ordinance drawn up regarding squealing tires. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.

Delmer Miller told the Council that the Chain Saw was worn out and that a new one was needed. He had checked on several makes and models and the price of each. The Council told him to get one with a larger motor than the one they now have.

Motion by Denny Sickles to buy a good chain saw with a large motor. Seconded by Robert Weiland. Carried.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to adjourn. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.
