**47.01 PURPOSE.** The purpose of this chapter is to facilitate the enjoyment of park facilities by the general public by establishing rules and regulations governing the use of park facilities.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12)

**47.02 FIRES.** No fire shall be built, except in a place designated for such purpose, and such fire shall be extinguished before leaving the area unless it is to be immediately used by some other party.

**47.03 LITTERING.** No person shall place, deposit, or throw any waste, refuse, litter or foreign substance in any area or receptacle except those provided for that purpose.

**47.04 ANIMALS.** No cats, dogs or other animals shall be permitted within the boundaries of the City park.

## **47.05 CAMPING.**

- 1. It is unlawful for any person to camp overnight within the boundaries of the City Park.
- 2. It is unlawful for any person to set up tents, shacks or other temporary shelters in the parks for the purpose of overnight camping.
