Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer Miller reported that the City was in great need of a new ladder (extension type) He had priced an aluminum ladder for 139.50 and the Fiberglass was 225.00 with round rungs and 242.00 with flat rungs.

Motion by Denny Sickles to buy a new fiberglass 24' extension ladder. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

Delmer had ask about a remote telephone type meter for the sub-station. The telephone company had quoted a \$125. installation charge and \$29. per month. The meter would cost approximately \$250. Heetland Electric would install and calibrate the meter.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to have a remote reader installed at the Sub Station. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.

Delmer reported that the street were in need of repair and that a load of Super Patch would be needed.

The lift Station pump is broke and will need to have new packing put in. Delmer reported that he would probably take the pump to Des Moines to have repaired.

Chief Ronald Highland reported that there had been dances at the school and at one of the taverns. As yet no complaints have been received about noise. In one of the other towns the officers had gone to the County Attorney but they were advised that unless there were a lot of complaints probably nothing would be done.

The City Clerk informed the Council that there were two workshops she would like to attend. One being the area Clerk's workshop to be held on April 19th at Mt. Ayr and the other was the Iowa Municipal Finance Officers Association Meeting to be held in Des Moines on April 26.

Motion by Denny Sickles to send Evelyn Rohner to the Area Workshop to be held April 19th and the IMFOA meeting on April 26 and to pay the registration fee for both. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.

Policeman Dan Richards will be attending the Police Academy starting May 7th. Because of the large class he is not sure where he will be going (either Des Moines or Indian Hills) Expenses include meals, milage, and part of the special clothing needed.

The reason the Mayor had ask for all members to be present is that he wanted to discuss the possibility of having Congregate Meals at the Community Center when it is finished. The Congregate meal site is to be out of the Catholic Church in Greenfield by May 25th, and they are looking for another meal site. The Government pays \$155. to \$160 and they serve from 60 to 80 each time. They do have their own deep freeze and refrigerator and dishes for 48. They would need a storage room to keep their things in. One of the drawbacks was that they are not sure that the room would be large enough for that many people. They would also require 2 commercials type stoves. Heat and electric costs would have to be taken into account. It was decided that Mayor Ralph Means and Kenneth Perry would visit with the head of the meal site to see what was needed and if they were interested.

The Contractor had said that by May 14th he needed to have the paneling and commercial carpet pcked out. The Mayor named Denny Sickles and Robert Edwards to servese on the committee to pick out both the paneling and carpet.
