Departmental reports were heard and correspondence read. Chief Ronald Highland stated that he had gotten 2 State Vehicle Bids. They were for the Ford Crown Victoria. The bids were \$11,136. for the 351 engine with cruise control, positraction and clock and extra dome light. The other bid was for the 302 engine which did not have the extra dome light and the amount was \$10,609. Some options would not be necessary on both cars, but that a 4 door model was a necessity. There was no decision at this time, but the Clerk was ask to put it on the February Agenda for a decision at that time.

The Clerk read correspondence from R.E. Hays & Associates regarding the updating of the City Code which has to be done in order to comply with state law. Motion by Denny Sickles to have R. E. Hays & Associates up-date the City Code. Seconded by Harold Veatch. Carried.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to introduce for its first consideration an "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS POSING A RISK OF DANGER TO PERSONS OR DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES AND REMEDIES". It was decided that some portions should be deleted. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.

Albert Eshelman and Bernard Baudler met with the Council regarding the electric outage caused by the tiling machine hitting the buried cable, and the charges rendered for those damages. Mr. Eshelman stated that he was not going to pay the damages as he does not feel that he was negligent in any way. The Council informed Mr. Eshelman that he should have ask for permission to dig and do tiling in that field since he knew that the cable was buried in that field, and if he had ask, the cable would have been located for him. The Council felt that as long as he knew that there was a line of underground cable he was responsible for the damages, and the City was asking only for what it cost for the actual repairs to get the electricity back on. It was decided that a Lawyer should be contacted to get a legal opinion. As far as Delmer Miller can find there is no set rule for distance between signs but there were signs on the road south of the sub-station

Motion by Bob Edwards to get an attorney's opinion regarding the cutting of the electric cable. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.

The Budget for the ensuing year was discussed.

Since the State has said that no other monies are to be included in the Road Use Tax Fund except what the State allocates to each City, the Interest Money is to be transferred into the General Street Fund.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to transfer interest monies from the Road Use Tax Fund into the General Fund, in the amount of \$973.70. Seconded by Bob Edwards. Carried.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to approve the newly elected officers for the Fontanelle-Summerset Fire Department. Those being: Fire Chief, Jon Ehrenfried Assistant Chief: Raymond Stewart; and Secretary/Treasurer, Delk Grantham. Seconded by Kenneth Perry. Carried.

Delmer Miller had been in contact with Solomon Electric Supply Co. regarding the rewinding of the Transformers. It was decided by the Council to go ahead and get the Westinghouse Transformer rewound.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to get the Westinghouse Transformer completely rewound with all new copper, added bracings and new oil for the quoted price of \$13,100. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.

Cleaning of the Community Center was discussed and an ad is to be placed in the Fontanelle Observer for those interested in the work.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to adjourn. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.
