

The City Council met in Special Session at City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Ralph D. Means presiding. Council Members present were: Robert Edwards, Gene Jacobsen, Denny Sickles, Kenneth Perry and Harold Veatch. Absent: None.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to approve the agenda as posted. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.

Motion by Robert Edwards to introduce a Resolution entitled "A Resolution establishing charges, conditions, and other terms of Offering in Conjunction with the Electric Service Tariff and Adopting Such Tariff." and moved for its adoption. Denny Sickles seconded the motion to adopt. Roll was called and the following voted: AYE: Gene Jacobsen, Kenneth Perry, Harold Veatch, Robert Edwards and Denny Sickles. NAY: None.

Whereupon the Mayor declared the Resolution duly adopted as:

RESOLUTION NO. 85.4

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CHARGES, CONDITIONS AND OTHER TERMS OF OFFERING IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ELECTRIC TARIFF AND ADOPTING SUCH TARIFF

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FONTANELLE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. Purpose. It is the purpose of this resolution to adopt the Electric Tariff No. 3 as of this date and to be effective on July 20, 1985 to authorize filing of same with the Iowa State Commerce Commission and to establish charges, conditions, and other terms of offering to be in effect in conjunction with said electric service tariff of the Fontanelle Municipal Utility. Charges, terms and conditions established by this resolution are subject to other such conditions and stipulations as may be required by the electric service tariff.

SECTION 2. Security Lights. In conjunction with Section 2.4(5) of the electric service tariff, the City will provide a security light at no charge or a lawn light at 50% of cost. The City will charge for any labor and materials required other than the light itself.

SECTION 3. Seasonal. In conjunction with Section 2.4(6) of the electric service tariff, the charge per month per transformer KVA installed shall be \$0.75.

SECTION 4. Temporary Service. In conjunction with Section 2.5(3) of the electric service tariff, the City will provide a standard, single-phase, 120/240 volt, 60 or 100 ampere, temporary service for a cash deposit of \$50.


SECTION 5. Three Phase Extensions. In conjunction with Section 2.5(4) of the electric service tariff: The deposit will be credited to the customer's account in equal monthly installment over a ten year period.

SECTION 6. Returned Checks. In conjunction with Section 3.3(7)d of the electric service tariff, the City will assess a service charge of \$5.00 for any returned checks.

SECTION 7. Reconnection Charges. In conjunction with Sections 3.4 and 3.5 of the electric service tariff the minimum reconnect charges shall be \$15.75.

SECTION 8. When Effective. This resolution shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

PASSED by the Council the 17th day of June, 1985 and APPROVED this 17th day of June, 1985.




Motion by Robert Edwards to raise Lois Ehrenfried's wages to \$4.25 per hour. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.
