

Section 4. TEMPORARY SERVICE. In conjunction with Section 2.5(3) of the electric service tariff, the City will provide a standard, single-phase, 120/240 volt, 60 or 100 ampere, temporary service for a cash deposit of \$50.00

Section 5. THREE PHASE EXTENSIONS. In conjunction with Section 2.5.(4) of the electric service tariff: The deposit will be credited to the customers account in equal monthly installments over a ten year period.

Section 6. RETURNED CHECKS. In conjunction with Section 3.3(7)d of the electric service tariff, the City will assess a service charge of \$5.00 for any returned checks.

Section 7. RECONNECTION CHARGES. In conjunction with Sections 3.4 and 3.5 of the electric service tariff the minimum reconnect charges shall be \$15.75.

Section 8. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
