Section 4. TEMPORARY SERVICE. In conjunction with Section 2.5(3) of the electric service tariff, the City will provide a standard, single-phase, 120/240 volt, 60 or 100 ampere, temporary service for a cash deposit of \$50.00

Section 5. THREE PHASE EXTENSIONS. In conjunction with Section 2.5.(4) of the electric service tariff: The deposit will be credited to the customers account in equal monthly installments over a ten

year period.

Section 6. RETURNED CHECKS. In conjunction with Section 3.3(7)d of the electric service tariff, the City will assess a service charge

of \$5.00 for any returned checks.

Section 7. RECONNECTION CHARGES. In conjunction with Sections
3.4 and 3.5 of the electric service tariff the minimum reconnect charges

shall be \$15.75.

Section 8. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law. PASSED by the Council this 8th day of July and APPROVED this 8th
