

The City Council met in Special Session at the City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Pro-Tem Harold Veatch presiding. Council Members present were: Denny Sickles, Kenneth Perry Gene Jacobsen and Robert Edwards.

Mr. Bob Pringle of Mid State Engineering and Mr. Doug DeBolt of Southern Iowa Council of Governments met with the Council regarding the water situation and CDBG Grant.

A preliminary report for waterworks improvement was presented.

SCOPE OF ENGINEERING SERVICES:

1. Identify the service area and complete a population projection
2. Determine the current average, maximum day and peak instantaneous usage.
3. Determine the design year average, day, maximum day and peak instantaneous usage.
4. Inspect existing wells and determine current capacity and physical condition.
5. Review the existing water quality data and compare with the primary and secondary drinking water regulations.
6. Determine a preliminary site for a new well.
7. Prepare cost estimate for new well and accessories.
8. Complete and submit Iowa Department of Water, Air, and Waste Management Schedule 4: Site Selection
9. Conduct a sampling and testing program on the treatment plant and distribution system. This will include the following:
 - a. Collect and test water samples for iron bacteria.
 - b. Conduct data collection and interviews with homeowners who historically have had problems with iron in the water
 - c. Coordinate samplings of affected water users.
 - d. Optional--automatic samplings of finished water
10. Determine the volume of storage recommended by ISO and IDWAWM.
11. Prepare a preliminary design and cost estimate for new storage tank.
12. Furnish typewritten copies of the report and present the same to Council.

Mr. Pringle said the cost for their services would be \$5,000 except for the sampling machine. The State might have one for rent, but the estimated cost for the rental would be about \$500.

Mr. Pringle also said that a mechanical clarifier removes iron before it even gets into the plant. However, the cost of that machine is \$50,000. Since we are against a time limit he wanted to know if the Council felt that they would like to include the price of this unit in the application for the Grant.

Motion by Denny Sickles to increase the application for a CDBG Grant with the City's contribution to be \$100,000. for Water Treatment and facilities. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.

Motion by Robert Edwards to approve the running of tests to be made by Mid State Engineering Co. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to adjourn. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.
