The Public Hearing that was scheduled for 8:00 p.m. had to be postponed due to the fact that the attorney was still in Court and he ask that the Hearing be held on February 3rd at the next regular Council Meeting.

Departmental Reports were heard and correspondence read.

Delmer Miller reported that the Electric Meeting at Greenfield was very informative. They haven't had any contract information from C.I.P.C.O. and will have to wait and see what SIMECA presents. Our only contract is with W.A.P.A. which lasts until 2001. Duane Armstead was interested in sharing the inter-tie line that we plan to build in the future, as it would interconnect with the line to Greenfield's Water Plant.

Bob Pringle of Mid-State Engineering met with the Council. He reported that his firm had been testing the water for a month. Through all this testing he finds that the real problem is right at the plant. They have found that due to the high content of iron the filters are not able to handle it. To make the water satisfactory the filters should be cleaned at least twice a day, as they don't make a filter to handle that much iron.

The Lab will try to find a chemical to settle out the iron.

He said that the plant should have sloped floors in the pits which would make it much easier to clean out the iron sludge.

Mr. Pringle suggested that the filters could be completely changed but felt it unnecessary at this time until more tests have been run. He hoped to have a more complete answer in about two weeks, and would like to meet with the Council at that time.
