All interested agencies, groups and persons disagreeing with this decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the City of Fontanelle to the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Fontanelle, Iowa. Such written comments should be received at the Office of the City Clerk on or before October, 23, 1986. All such comments so received will be considered and the City will not request the release of CDBG funds or take any administrative action on the

project prior to the date specified in the preceding sentence.

The City of Fontanelle, Iowa will undertake the project described above with Block Grant funds from the Department of Economic Development under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. The City of Fontanelle, Iowa and Ralph Means, in his official capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if any action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision-making and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval the City of Fontanelle, Iowa may use the Block Grant funds and IDED will have satisfied its responsibilities under the Environmental Policy Act of 1969. IDED will accept an objection to its approval only if it is on one of the following bases: (a) that the certification was not in fact executed by the certifying officer, or (b) that the applicant's environmental review record for the project indicates omission of a required decision, finding or step applicable to the project in the environmental review process. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedure (24CFR Par 58) and may be addressed to IDED, Division of Local Government Affairs, 200 East Grand Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50319.

Objections to the release of funds on bases other than those stated above will not be considered by IDED. No objections received after November 12, 1986 will be considered by IDED.
