Fontanelle, Iowa
March 24, 1987

The City Council met in Special Session at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Ralph D. Means presiding. Council Members present were: Denny Sickles, Gene Jacobsen and Kenneth Perry. Absent: Harold Veatch and Robert Edwards.

The purpose of the meeting was to meet with the City Attorney Zane Blessum and Mr. David Kohn President of Great Plains Cable T.V.

Sixteen citizens of the town also were in attendance.

Mr. Kohn stated that in October or November of 1985 the share holders found many problems. There was a vast shortage of money in the amount of \$650,000. so there had to be a restruction of the Company. To make matters worse the C.R.O. system was not computerized so records were non existant, and they have been unable to find any trace of them. He stated that it cost between 125,000 and 150,000 to build and as yet they have not had a bread even year. Out of the 325 homes in Fontanelle only 160 have taken cable. Most of these have the basic. A very few have premium channels. Descramblers cost \$600. each. To expand just 1 channel it costs the company \$2300 plus the \$600 for the descrambler.

Thesenior citizens age is 72 for a \$5. discount. Many complained that the age should be much lower.

The gravel bill was discussed. After some deliberation Mr. Kohn ask if the Council would settle for \$1250. instead of \$2200.

Motion by Denny Sickles to accept the offer of Great Plains Co. of \$1250. for the gravel bill to repair the alleys. Seconded by Kenneth Perry. Carried.

A special note is to be included with the Fontanelle billing. Any problems with billing or service the people are to call the 800 number. This will be relayed to Steve Marckmann for repairs.

Mr. Kohn gave an indication that possibly the city could buy the Cable Co. with an estimated cost of \$125,000.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to adjour. Seconded by Denny Sickles. Carried.
