Motion by Kenneth Perry to look into the price of a K-55 Radar Unit and to get two spare wheels for the Police Car. Seconded by Sally Sorensen. Carried.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to approve the building permit of Melvin

Laughery for a new house. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

Motion by Sally Sorensen to approve the building permit of Verlene Brownrigg for a carport on the east side of her house. Seconded by Kenneth Perry. Carried.

David Jungmann will prepare an Ordinance and Resolution for the purpose of closing the alley between the C. J. Dory and Mildred Pickrell residences.

John Potts of Mid State Engineering presented bills for Maguire Iron and for Mid-State Engineering.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to approve the bill of Maguire Iron in the amount of \$19,380 and Mid-State Engineering in the amount of \$934.00. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

Motion by Robert Edwards to authorize the Mayor Pro-Tem to sign the draw down. Seconded by Sally Sorensen. Carried.

There have been many requests to have the name of Fontanelle painted on the other side of the water tower. John Potts will check into the price of having it painted.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to apply for a 1988 Community Development Block Grant for sewer improvements. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried.

Motion by Gene Jacobsen to set 7:00 P.M. on November 7th as the time for a Public Hearing for receiving input from the General Public regarding improvement to the sewer system. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

Eric Gross and Clarence Marckmann representing the Shelter Committee asked approval of the Council for the building sight for the shelter. Mayor Pro-Tem Albert Ehrenfried ask the Council to have Kenneth Perry and Delmer Miller assist in the placement of the shelter.

Council Member Kenneth Perry introduced the Ordinance amending the City Code Title II, Division 1, Chapter 2, Article III. for its second reading. Roll was called with the following voting: AYE: Sorensen, Edwards, Jacobsen, Perry and Ehrenfried.

Motion by Robert Edwards to waive the 3rd reading of the Ordinance. Seconded by Gene Jacobsen. Carried. Roll was called with all voting AYE.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to finally adopt the Ordinance and assign it the number of Ordinance No. 126. Seconded by Sally Sorensen. Roll was called with the following voting: AYE: Kenneth Perry, Robert Edwards, Gene Jacobsen, Sally Sorensen and Albert Ehrenfried. NAY: None.

Whereupon, the Mayor Pro-Tem declared the Ordinance duly passed and approved as Ordinance No. 126.

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE II DIVISION I  
CHAPTER II, ARTICLE III OF THE CITY CODE  
OF FONTANELLE, IOWA.

2.1-2.0320 RIDING OR WALKING HORSES OR MULES UPON SIDEWALKS AND RESTRICTING HOURS FOR RIDING. No person shall ride or walk any horse or mule upon any sidewalk or in the city parks within the City of Fontanelle at any time. Riding or walking any horse or mule on any street within the City of Fontanelle is prohibited from the hours of one hour before sunset to one hour after sunrise. Violation of this ordinance shall be considered a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine no exceeding \$100.00.

This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Due to the many comments about having the tower painted with only one side sayin "FONTANELLE" the council discussed having them come back and paint the name on the other side. The company charges \$50. a letter besides \$250. to set up the rigging. The approximate cost would be \$1,000.

Motion by Sally Sorensen to have the Maguire Iron Co. crew come back and paint "FONTANELLE" on the other side of the tower. Seconded by Albert Ehrenfried. Carried.

It was decided to publish a notice of a public hearing regarding the repealing of part of the fire zone code.
