> ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE II, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, SUBSECTION 2.1-2.0602

2.1-2.0602, Title II, Division 1, Chapter 2, Article 6 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefore:

SPECIAL STOPS REQUIRED. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop in accordance with the following:

- Scott Street. Vehicles traceling on Scott Street whall stop at Fourth Street.
- Vehicles traveling East on Main Street shall stop at Third Street, Fourth Street and Eighthn Street. Vehicles traveling west on Main Street shall stop at Third Street, Fifth Street and Eighth Street.
- 3. Jefferson Street. Vehicles traveling on Jefferson Street shall stop at Fourth Street and Sixth Street.
- 4. Maple Street. Vehicles traveling on Maple Street shall stop at Fourth Street and Seventh Street.
- 5. First Street. Vehicles traveling on First Street shall stop at Maple Street.
- Third Street Vehicles traveling on Third Street shall stop at Main Street.
