

The Council told Delmer Miller that if someone was needed to help work on streets to get someone that they felt they could work with and they would be paid \$5.00 per hour.

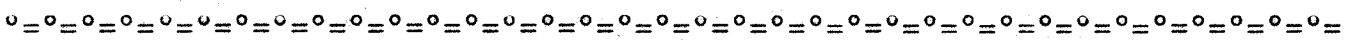
It was brought up that the walls of the Community Center were in need of being painted.

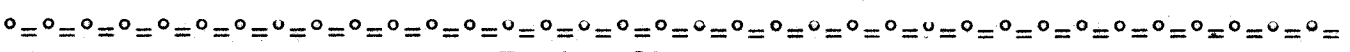

The Fire and Rescue Management Committee met at City Hall at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tem Albert Ehrenfried presiding. Committee Members present were: Robert Edwards, Sally Sorensen, Roger Frank, Kenneth Perry and Leroy Nelson. Absent: Max Jacobson.

Motion by Kenneth Perry to approve the agenda as posted. Seconded by Roger Frank. Carried.

Motion by Robert Edwards to approve the minutes of the last meeting as read by the Clerk. Seconded by Leroy Nelson. Carried.

Motion by Sally Sorensen to approve the Finance Report as given. Seconded by Roger Frank. Carried.

Motion by Leroy Nelson to approve bills for payment. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

Chief Ray Stewart reported that since December 18th there had been 13 rescue calls, 8 fire calls and 6 meetings with 171 people responding which makes a total of \$684.00 due the Department.

NFPA Standards were discussed. The main objective is for safety which will have to be in effect in 4 years. They are proposing new helmets, gloves, coats and pants which are like overalls. They also suggest hoods to be worn under the helmets. They are requesting short boots and short coats instead of the long ones now used.

Chief Stewart had catalogues from Ed Feld Co. and Hyman Co. Motion by Sally Sorensen to buy 13 of the new type helmets. Seconded by Robert Edwards. Carried.

EMS Regulations are much more strict for 1989.

The water truck should be ready by July 4th. Chief Stewart is to write a "Thank You" to the Farmer's Co-op for all their help to the Fire Department.

The Department had received money from the state which was to be spent for EMS training or Training Aids, so the Department is getting a TV, VCR and Stand to show training films.
