Motion by Gene Jacobsen to pay one-half the cost of the tree removal from the parking at the Don Baudler residence. Seconded by Sally Sorensen. Carried.

Delmer Miller reported on the Electric Tie-line to Greenfield. He said that Greenfield's line is not large enough to carry the load. He had talked to Richard Dix about hooking up with REC but had not received a reply. Delmer thought that the City should give something towards a 1500KVA line to take care of Fontanelle or give Greenfield money to build up their line to handle the load.

The town lot was brought up again. The Council suggested that Delmer talk to Bill Dodson about a small piece of land which is used to store machinery at the present time.

Don Baudler ask about building a driveway at his residence which would come out on 4th Street. He ask if a tube was needed under the drive. He thought that it might be possible to run the slope to the ditch line in order to make a little swail so the water would have someplace to go.

The date of December 13th was set for the annual Christmas party to be held at the Community Center.
